

Mozambique: exiled lawyer sends Chissano draft constitution *(Text)* An exiled Mozambican lawyer, Domingos Arouca, who is in Portugal and opposes the Frelimo Party, has sent his own draft for a new Mozambican constitution to President Joaquim Chissano. Mr Arouca was asked by President Chissano to do this when the Mozambican leader visited Portugal in April. President Chissano has invited all Mozambicans living abroad to contribute to the current nationwide debate on the draft of a new constitution drawn up by the Frelimo Party. Mr Arouca's draft calls for a multi-party political system, creation of autonomous regions, appointment of an equivalent of an ombudsman, and the use of referenda. Mr Arouca told the Mozambique News Agency that he intends to return to Mozambique next October, ending his 15 years of exile. *(Radio Maputo in English for abroad 1100 gmt 20 Jul 90)*
